David H. Martin Excavating

Family-run business relies on products, values for decades.

Plenty has changed about David H. Martin Excavating since the company was founded in Chambersburg, Pa., in 1968. It grew from one man with a financed backhoe and dump truck to a company that employs about 220.

The reins have been passed down from its namesake to his three sons, and is now run by Kirk Martin, grandson of the founder and company president. Martin's job sites have also grown, from small locally financed operations to projects for some of the world's largest companies.

Through its period of exponential growth, there has been one constant: J&J Truck Bodies. David H. Martin's fleet of 38 triaxle, eight single-axle, and two tandemaxle trucks all feature J&J bodies. So what keeps David H. Martin coming back to J&J Truck Bodies & Trailers year after year? "I think their quality," Kirk Martin said. "They run a high-quality bed. We don't have too much with failures. If we do – and everybody is going to from time to time – J&J has stood behind their product."

Although he's since bought the company from his father and uncles, Kirk Martin started working on job sites when he was 14 years old. After high school, he didn't attend college, but instead went to work in the field for his family's company. That's where he learned the value of hard work – and of having hard-working equipment to rely on to get the job done right. "It's really important to have that basis and understanding of why you do what you're doing," he said.

David H. Martin's varied operations – the company serves commercial, residential and agricultural customers and performs an assortment of tasks – mean it needs hard-working trucks capable of hauling an array of materials. J&J Truck Bodies & Trailers has built aluminum Material Haulers (MH), Lightweight Crossmemberless (LWC) and steel Semi-Elliptical (SE) beds for Martin's company.

"We're pretty versatile. If it will fit in the bed and is not going to damage the bed, we'll haul it," he said. "We are site contractors, so the steel beds are out on site working quite a bit, hauling rocks, trees, and brush in them. Our aluminum beds are transporting slate, stone, and sand."

J&J's material hauler has been the go-to product for David H. Martin. "That's our basic bed that we use," Kirk Martin said. "We've changed it around a little bit over the years, as far as where the tarp arms are or shovel holders are. J&J has worked with us. Our spec is a little bit different than anybody else, but it works for us. J&J has been pretty accommodating."

Just as the brown-and-orange David H. Martin trucks have become a familiar site in and around Chambersburg, so, too, has the J&J logo. "We're pretty picky on how our equipment looks and keeping it clean and painted," Kirk Martin said. "I think J&J's values coincide with ours as a company."





These trucks were recently completed for the Delaware Department of Transportation and will be used for roadway maintenance and field service repairs. They are fully loaded with generators, sign boards, backup cameras, adjustable work lights, and lots of compartments for tool and equipment storage. Great all-around work trucks!
